

### **Anthony Brindisi fights for our veterans**

- Brindisi has made care for our nation's veterans a top priority.
- He serves on the Veterans' Affairs Committee.

- On September 30, President Trump signed Brindisi's bill into law to extend programs to help low-income and rural veterans
- Another bill of his, the Support for Suicide Prevention Coordinators Act, passed the House unanimously. The bill would help improve suicide prevention and mental health resources for veterans.
- He also passed a bill to increase accessibility of VA services for women veterans.
- On Veterans Day, he held a town hall for local veterans to hear their concerns and discuss his work on the Veterans' Affairs committee.
- All of Brindisi's work for veterans is bipartisan. Caring for our nation's veterans is an issue Democrats and Republicans can agree on.

### **Anthony Brindisi is a champion for our farmers**

- Brindisi serves on the House Agriculture Committee
- He formed a local Agriculture Advisory Committee, which he listens to for ideas to bring to Congress.
- Brindisi's bipartisan Seeding Rural Resilience Act would increase access to mental health care in rural areas.
- He has held Dairy Margin Coverage workshops throughout the area to help farmers sign up for this new program.
- He brought Agriculture Secretary Sonny Perdue to the area to show him the importance of the local dairy industry.
- He is championing a trade deal to help our dairy farmers in trade with Canada.
- Brindisi introduced the bipartisan Dairy and Sheep H-2A Visa Enhancement Act to address the dairy workforce shortage.

### **Anthony Brindisi fights for lower prescription drug costs**

- Brindisi is fighting for seniors.
- Brindisi supports H.R. 3, the Lower Drug Costs Now Act, which requires Medicare to negotiate drug prices with pharmaceutical companies, including bringing down the cost of insulin.
- H.R. 3 would create a \$2,000 out-of-pocket limit on prescription drug costs for seniors under the Medicare prescription drug benefit.

- Brindisi introduced the Ensuring Timely Access to Generics Act with Republican John Joyce, which would bring more generic drugs to the marketplace and drive down the costs of prescriptions.

### **Anthony Brindisi named to powerful Armed Services Committee**

- Brindisi's work as an effective problem-solver has been recognized by his colleagues, who chose him for a spot on the Armed Services Committee.
- This is a big win for the region. Brindisi will advocate for Rome Lab, DFAS, and the Eastern Air Defense Sector.
- Brindisi will fight to keep jobs and federal funding in our area.
- Brindisi will advocate for a strong national defense.
- He will continue to serve on the Veterans' Affairs and Agriculture Committees, where he fights for our nation's veterans and farmers.
